The following questions/responses relate to the Request for Proposal #918429, "Household Moving Services", that is scheduled for public receipt on Tuesday, April 14, 2009 at 2:00 PM Local Time. This information has been posted on the University Purchasing website, located at: <http://purchasing.unl.edu/>.

1. Question: On page 4, Section 1.4, paragraph F states that Carrier will deliver household goods within 72 hours... In some cases, excessive mileage (over 1,500), and minimum shipment sizes can make this impossible. Is there a specific size move and distance we can base off of this to agree to? Or would it be best to submit out "Transit Time Guide" as a supplement? UNL could use it as additional Basis of Selection criterion. Or would I need to apply an exception to this? **Response: The entire sentence states, "Carrier will deliver household goods to the intended location within seventy-two (72) hours or three (3) days after pickup or as arranged and scheduled with the employee.**

It is our intent that the successful Carrier(s) provide reasonable expedited service and maintain communication with the University employee receiving the service regarding the status of pickup and delivery schedules, as well as any variations that might occur. It is not the University's intent to require deliveries that would violate any rules, regulations or create unsafe situations for the Carrier/driver or the household goods.


If you would like to submit a "Transit Time Guide" or provide exceptions we will take these submittals into consideration.

2. Question: Would UNL want a CD-ROM copy of our proposal as well? **Response: A CD-ROM copy is not required.**
3. Question: In order to give accurate pricing, could you provide us with the origin City and State that we should use for this shipment. Page 9, #16, Sample Move 1: Interstate Move? **Response: Please use Atlanta, Georgia, zip code 30318.**
